



If you are eligible for Self Directed Support (assessed by the local authority) you have four options on how you choose to receive this support.



Option 1: Direct Payment

The local authority gives you the funds and you manage/direct and arrange your own support. For instance, you could use the money to buy support from Crossroads.

Option 2: You Direct Your Support

The local authority allocates a budget to you and you control how and where this is spent. However, the local authority or a care provider handles the funds on your behalf, under your direction. This is known as an Individual Service Fund. You can choose Crossroads to deliver your support plan and/or administer your budget for you.

Option 3: Support is Arranged for You

The local authority arranges and manages support services on your behalf and may purchase these services from Crossroads.

Option 4: Mix and Match

This is a combination of options 1, 2 and 3 from above.

Information for Carers

A carer is someone "who provides care to family members, other relatives, partners, friends and neighbours of any age affected by physical or mental illness (often long term) disability, frailty or substance misuse".

If you are an unpaid carer who provides a lot of support to someone, you may also be entitled to some paid support under the same four options.
